

PRIVACY DECLARATION ARMYHOST

ArmyHost, Chamber of Commerce: 81745095 (hereinafter “we”, “us”, “us”) applies the following conditions for all customers (hereinafter “you”, “the customer”, “the customers”) those of <https://armyhost.nl> (hereinafter “the website”) and the products/services offered by us (hereinafter “the service”, “the services”) buy or use.

1. Personal data that we process

1.1: We process personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide it to us yourself. Below you will find an overview of the personal data that we process:

- Name and address details
- E-mail address
- Phone number
- Date of birth
- Sex
- IP address

2. Special and/or sensitive personal data that we process

2.1: The website and/or service does not intend to collect data about visitors under the age of 16 (hereinafter referred to as “child”, “children”). Unless they have permission from parents or guardian.

2.2: However, we cannot check whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore advise parents to be involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent.

2.3: In the event that we have collected information about a child without parental consent, please contact us at armyhost@armyhost.nl and we will delete this information.

3. For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data

3.1: We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- Handling your order and payment.
- To be able to e-mail you if this is necessary to be able to carry out our services.
- To inform you about changes to our services and products.

- To deliver services to you.
- To protect our customers

3. Automated decision making

4.1: We make decisions based on automated processing on matters that can have (significant) consequences for people. This concerns decisions taken by computer programs or systems, without involving a person (for example, an employee of ours). We use the following computer programs or systems: an automatic ordering, invoicing and payment system to automate your orders, payments and invoices so that we do not outsource unnecessary time.

4.2: If an error has been made on the basis of one of the automated processing(s) mentioned, you should contact us at armyhost@armyhost.nl.

4. How long we keep personal data

5.1: We keep your personal data until you delete your account with your personal data. You can request a deletion of your account by sending an e-mail to: armyhost@armyhost.nl or creating a ticket via the website.

5. Sharing personal data with third parties

6.1: We do not provide personal data to third parties, unless this has been discussed with you in advance or to comply with a legal obligation.

6. Cookies, or similar techniques we use

7.1: A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet, smartphone or other device when you (first) visit the website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and, for example, remember your preferred settings.

7.2: We use functional cookies to ensure that the website works properly. These cookies are therefore also necessary for the use of the website and cannot be disabled.

7.3: We use session cookies to keep track of how many people view the website and where they are located on the website. These cookies are part of our live chat system and therefore cannot be disabled.

7.4: If you do not agree with the cookies we use, the website will unfortunately not be usable.

7. View, modify or delete data

8.1: You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data.

You can do this yourself via the personal settings of your account.

8.2: You have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by us, after this it is unfortunately no longer possible to provide you with services

8.3: You have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data we have about you in a computer file to you or another organization mentioned by you.

d) If you want to make use of your right or objection and/or right to data portability or if you have other questions/comments about data processing, please send a specified request to armyhost@armyhost.nl with a copy of your proof of identity. To protect your privacy, make this copy of the citizen service number, passport number, MRZ (machine readable zone) and the passport photo black.

8. How we protect personal data

9.1: We take the protection of your data seriously and take appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, disclosure and unauthorized modification. We do this, for example, by using SSL certificates on the website, storing your passwords and other sensitive data with which access to your account can be obtained with strong encryption algorithms. Our databases are protected with a strong password and only accessible locally. This makes external access (almost) impossible.
